Comments

The highly unique symbolism lends to the originality of this theme. Yet as the premise unfolds it becomes fairly confusing. For example it's difficult to discern the meaning of the lines, "That grass looks greener because you've never been meaner going to have to graze on it lay around for days on it etc." If the listener can't understand the metaphor than they're less likely to make an emotional connection. Work harder on clarity and line to line logic.

Definitions

Number Ratings: Judges rate the components of each song on a scale from 1 to 10. A rating of '1' suggests a need for major improvement, '5' is average and a rating of '10' signifies excellence.

Title/Hook: Is the title memorable and interesting? Does the lyric contain a distinct and engaging chorus, refrain and/or centralized hook?

Clarity/Theme Development: Is the meaning of the lyric effectively communicated? Is the central theme focused and developed?

Imagery: Does the lyric contain vivid images and/or memorable phrases?

Rhyming: Is there a consistent rhyming pattern? Are rhymes fresh and engaging?

Structure: Is there a cohesive lyrical structure? Are the structural components (verse, chorus, bridge) effectively designed?

Adaptability: Can these lyrics be successfully adapted to music?

Originality: Is the overall lyric distinctive and communicated in a fresh way?
